

Council Chambers

Council met in adjourned session with Mayor Don Reed presiding and roll call showing Councilmembers: Donald Button, Jack Wallace, Sheila Backstrom, Justin Begnoche, Lanny Crawford, Sharon Brown and Charles Smith present.

Appropriation Ordinance Nos. 3158 and 3159, allowing claims, which had been checked by the Council were presented. Moved by Councilmember Brown, seconded by Councilmember Crawford, that these ordinances be approved for payment. Upon being put to a vote by roll call this motion carried by a unanimous vote of all Councilmembers present.

City Clerk, Calvin Wohler, made a request to transfer \$80,000.00 from the General Operating Fund to the Street, Building, Machinery and Equipment Fund as a year end transaction. Moved by Councilmember Button, seconded by Councilmember Wallace, to transfer funds as recommended by the City Clerk. The motion carried unanimously.

Committee reports were as follows:

Ways and Means -Committee had a meeting yesterday, December 27, 2006 to discuss salary increases. Committee recommends to the Council a 5% raise for everyone as put in the 2007 budget. Moved by Councilmember Button, seconded by Councilmember Wallace, to give a .5% raise to all employees beginning with the first pay period in 2007. The motion carried unanimously.

Fire Department -Councilmember Wallace reminded the Council that the reserve fund should be allowed to increase to purchase a fire truck in a few years.

City Parks and Pool-Moved by Councilmember Begnoche, seconded by Councilmember Brown, to transfer \$10,000.00 out of General Operating Fund to the Pool Capital Improvement Fund. The motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Councilmember Begnoche, seconded by Councilmember Brown, to encumber \$10,000.00 for new roofs on two picnic shelters in the Parks. The motion carried unanimously.

Cemetery Department-Moved by Councilmember Wallace, seconded by Councilmember Crawford, to encumber \$5,000.00 for tree removal on cemetery grounds and \$5,000.00 toward a mower in 2007. The motion carried unanimously.

Lights. Water. and Sewer-A report was given to each councilmember showing the amount of brush, compost and recycling handled in 2006.

Airport-There will be a committee meeting on January 9, 2007 at 5:00 p.m. to make plans for the next improvement project.

New Business-Mr. Wohler presented a list of all the 2007 license renewals that will expire on December

31,2006.
