Council met in special session for the purpose of interviewing applicants for the Third Ward vacant seat with Mayor Sharon Brown presiding and roll call showing Councilmembers: Steve Fox, Justin Begnoche, Daton Hess, Butch Hess, Charles Smith, Connie Jordan and Jack Wallace present.

The Council received four applications for the open seat on the Council. They are Rhys Baker, Noel Carlson, James Brown and Carl (Tom) Nelson. Fifteen minute interviews were scheduled for each applicant beginning at 6:45 P.M. The order of interviewing was Rhys Baker, Noel Carlson, James Brown and Tom Nelson. Each councilmember asked two selected questions of each applicant.

Applicants were sequestered until Council was ready to interview them. Each applicant was asked the same questions.

After the interviews were over it was moved by Councilmember Wallace, seconded by Councilmember Begnoche, to have a ten minute Executive Session for the purpose of discussing non-elected personnel matters and only councilmembers being present. The motion carried unanimously.

The meeting reconvened after ten minutes.

Council voted individually who they chose to fill the Third Ward council seat. Rhys Baker received five votes and Tom Nelson received two votes. Councilmembers Fox, Begnoche, D.Hess, Jordan and Wallace voted for Rhys Baker and B.Hess and Charles Smith voted for Tom Nelson. Rhys Baker will fill the vacant Third Ward seat for the next two years.

Moved by Councilmember Wallace, seconded by Councilmember Begnoche, to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried unanimously. The meeting was adjourned.
