

CLAY CENTER CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
JULY 7, 2020

The Clay Center City Council met in regular session on July 7 in the Council Chambers. Public Services: Councilor D. Hess reported on the following: 1. The sales tax received in June for April was \$37,510.58. 2. The street department is patching potholes. 3. Crack sealing will be done in the near future. 4. Asphalt work will start towards the end of July.
