We will do our best to accommodate your requests to the best of our ability. Requests for more practice time than 1 week day and 1 weekend day will only be considered once all teams have been scheduled for at least one practice. There is no charge for practice time, but minimal field maintenance (raking, trash pickup) is expected following your practice time. Coaches will be e-mailed with their practice details as soon as possible upon submission of request. Any practice times assigned will only be honored until MAY 10 th as City League Baseball and Softball teams will start practices the week of May 11th. Once all City League teams are scheduled for practices, non-city league teams may request new practice times based on what is available.

Clay of Clay Center Recreation Department Baseball & Softball Practice Rules and Regulations



The following rules and regulations shall apply to the use of the fields for practice for baseball and softball teams.

- Respect the practice time of teams before and after your team. Start and finish on time.
- Unauthorized use of any fields/facilities is prohibited and may lead to non-use.
- The City of Clay Center has the right to cancel practices due to weather or poor field conditions due to weather. Use of infield is prohibited when/if fields are wet or muddy.
- Post practice maintenance is expected and consists of raking around all bases, pitchers area, and home plate. Rakes will be provided for each field. Trash must be picked up and dugout and field should clear of all debris before leaving.
- No alcohol beverages or illegal drugs allowed on/in City facilities.
- Use of the fields is subject to applicable provisions of the City of Clay Center code and state law.
- Weapons of all types are prohibited on/in all City facilities.
- Pets are not allowed on City of Clay Center facilities. (Service animals are always welcome.)
- Parking is limited to designated areas only.
- Speed limit is 10 mph unless otherwise posted.
- Littering is prohibited.
- No person shall damage or destroy City of Clay Center property of any kind or any property of others in the facility or otherwise interfere with the use of the facility by the public.
